From the Pastor:

I am not sure if this is caused directly by the Corona pandemic or from some other reasons, but it is noticeable. My theory is that there is a tremendous amount of frustration that folks have because of all the hardships that the virus has caused. 
Jesus gave us the paradigm for tolerance, patience, forgiveness and understanding from the cross when he said, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do".



NOTICE TO CLIENTS OF PETE'S PANTRY

We are going to continue having the tailgate food distributions on Thursday mornings through the month of May. But then, after much thought, it has been decided that starting on Thursday, June 3rd we will move pantry operations back inside the Church basement as we were doing before Covid 19 hit.

Our new days and hours will be:

Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 9:30 to 10:50 am

The pantry will be conducted much the same as before but with a few additional precautions.

You will still be required to show a bill or statement of some sort that shows your name, address and a current date as proof of residency.

If you are picking food up for someone else, you will still have to have a signed and dated permission note from that person.

You will be able get food 3 times a month.

EVERYONE WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR A MASK. YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO USE HAND SANITIZER AND YOUR TEMPERATURE WILL BE CHECKED WHEN YOU SIGN IN.

WE WILL ALSO BE LIMITING THE NUMBER OF CLIENTS THAT

CAN BE IN THE PANTRY AT THE SAME TIME AND WILL BE

REQUIRING THAT YOU SOCIAL DISTANCE FROM EACH OTHER.
