Eastern Europe Crisis Response

Since Russian troops invaded Ukraine four weeks ago there have been hundreds of thousands of civilians fleeing the destruction of their homeland and seeking refuge in neighboring countries. Many of these folks lack even the barest of necessities like food and shelter. Civilian targets like hospitals and schools are regularly being targeted by the Russian military, which makes matters even worse.

Lutheran Disaster Response is partnering with other humanitarian groups to try to alleviate some of the suffering, but they obviously need funds to do this. The ELCA is asking congregations to give generously to this effort. 100% of the money donated will go directly to the persons who need it most.
